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Summary of PHARMAC decisions

EFFECTIVE 1 JUNE 2017

New listings (page 25)

- Testosterone (Androderm) patch 5 mg per day
- Amoxicillin with clavulanic acid (Curam) grans for oral liq amoxicillin 50 mg with clavulanic acid 12.5 mg per ml, 100 ml OP – up to 200 ml available on a PSO
- Celecoxib (Celecoxib Pfizer) cap 100 mg and 200 mg

Changes to restrictions (pages 26-27)

- Amiodarone hydrochloride (Lodi and Cordarone-X) inj 50 mg per ml, 3 ml ampoule – PSO quantity amended to 5 inj available on a PSO
- Sulphadiazine silver (Flamazine) crm 1%, 50 g OP – amended chemical name
- Dimethicone (healthE Dimethicone 4% Lotion) lotn 4%, 200 ml OP – amended Therapeutic subgroup
- Amoxicillin with clavulanic acid (Augmentin) grans for oral liq amoxicillin 25 mg with clavulanic acid 6.25 mg per ml and grans for oral liq amoxicillin 50 mg with clavulanic acid 12.5 mg per ml – amended presentation description
- Venlafaxine (Efexor XR) cap 37.5 mg, 75 mg and 150 mg –Special Authority removed
- Temozolomide (Orion Temozolomide) cap 5 mg, 20 mg, 100 mg and 250 mg – amended Special Authority criteria
- Peptide-based oral feed (Peptamen Junior) powder – amended chemical name and Therapeutic subgroup resulting in new Special Authority required

Decreased subsidy (page 30)

- Amiodarone hydrochloride (Cordarone-X) inj 50 mg per ml, 3 ml ampoule
- Nifedipine (Adalat 10) tab long-acting 10 mg

- Leflunomide (Arava) tab 10 mg and 20 mg
- Venlafaxine (Arrow-Venlafaxine XR) tab 37.5 mg, 75 mg, 150 mg and 225 mg
- Venlafaxine (Efexor XR) cap 37.5 mg, 75 mg and 150 mg
- Sumatriptan (Arrow-Sumatriptan) tab 50 mg and 100 mg

What's changing?

The following Tender products will be listed from 1 June 2017:

- Amoxicillin with clavulanic acid (Curam) grants for oral liq amoxicillin 50 mg clavulanic acid 12.5 mg per ml, 100 ml OP

Curam contains a syringe and an adaptor and will be claimed as an Original Pack (OP), therefore wastage will not apply. We ask that pharmacists dispense in the proprietary bottle, along with the adaptor and syringe.



New listings

Celecoxib (Celecoxib Pfizer) caps

Celecoxib (Celecoxib Pfizer) 100 mg and 200 mg capsules will be listed, from 1 June 2017. There will be no restriction applying to this listing.

Changed listings

Venlafaxine (Efexor XR) – removal of Special Authority

This is a reminder about the timeframes for the venlafaxine brand change:

From 1 June 2017:

- Efexor XR and Arrow-Venlafaxine will be referenced priced to Enlafax XR and a manufacturer's surcharge will apply. Enlafax XR is the fully funded alternative.
- The Special Authority for Efexor XR will no longer be required, this means all patients taking Efexor XR will be able to get the part subsidy regardless of whether they had a Special Authority.

From 1 September 2017:

- The Efexor XR and Arrow-Venlafaxine brands will be delisted from the Pharmaceutical Schedule, Enlafax XR will be the sole supply brand.
- A Brand Switch Fee will apply to dispensings of Enlafax XR from 1 September 2017 to 30 November 2017.

Peptide-based oral feed (Peptamen Junior)

The chemical name for this product will change and it will move to the Paediatric Products section (from Infant formula, Gastrointestinal and other Malabsorptive problems). The Special Authority criteria applying to Paediatric products will apply from 1 June 2017. Prescribers for existing patients have been asked to apply for Special Authority approval using the Paediatric Products application form (SA1379) to ensure continued funded access to this treatment. From 1 June 2017, SA1379 approval is required for subsidy of both new and repeat dispensings.

Stock issues

Testosterone (Androderm) patches

A 5 mg testosterone (Androderm) patch will be listed from 1 June 2017, but will be available from mid-June. The 2.5 mg patch has been out-of-stock since late 2016, however, a small quantity of stock of the 2.5 mg patch is expected in mid-June along with the 5 mg patch.

Delists

Escitalopram (Loxalate) 10 mg tablet – Delist from 1 July 2017

The Loxalate brand of escitalopram 10 mg tablet will be delisted from 1 July 2017. This brand was listed in February 2017 in response to an out-of-stock of the Air Flow brand. Supply of the Air Flow brand has resumed.

Alprazolam – reminder

A reminder that alprazolam (Xanax) tablets will be delisted from 1 September 2017. Prescribers will need to transition their patients to alternative treatments prior to this date.

News in brief

- **Morphine tartrate** (Hospira) injection – The 80 mg per ml, 5 ml ampoule injection will be delisted from 1 December 2017. The 80 mg per ml, 1.5 ml ampoule remains available.
- **Amiodarone hydrochloride** (Lodi and Cordarone-X) 50 mg per ml, 3 ml injections – change in quantity available on a PSO from 6 to 5 injections to reflect the Tender brand (Lodi) pack size of 5 injections.
- **Dimethicone 4% lotion (for headlice)** – we incorrectly listed dimethicone 4% lotion in the barrier creams section of the Pharmaceutical Schedule. We will move this to the parasiticial preparations section.

Looking Forward

This section is designed to alert both pharmacists and prescribers to possible future changes to the Pharmaceutical Schedule. It may also assist pharmacists, distributors and wholesalers to manage stock levels.

Decisions for implementation 1 July 2017

- Haemophilus influenzae type B vaccine (Hiberix) haemophilus Influenzae type B polysaccharide 10 mcg conjugated to tetanus toxoid as carrier protein 20-40 mcg; prefilled syringe plus vial 0.5 ml – new listing
- Hepatitis B recombinant vaccine (HBvaxPRO) inj 5 mcg per 0.5 ml vial and inj 10 mcg per 1 ml vial – amended restriction
- Measles, mumps and rubella vaccine (Priorix) injection, measles virus 1,000 CCID50, mumps virus 5,012 CCID50, Rubella virus 1,000 CCID50; prefilled syringe/ampoule of diluent 0.5 ml – new listing
- Metoprolol succinate (Betaloc CR) tab long-acting 23.75 mg – new listing
- Olopatadine (Patanol) eye drops 0.1%, 5 ml OP – price and subsidy decrease
- Paracetamol (Pharmacare) tab 500 mg – bottle pack – new listing
- Paroxetine (Apo-Paroxetine) tab 20 mg – Brand Switch Fee payable

- Rotavirus oral vaccine (Rotarix) oral susp live attenuated human rotavirus 1,000,000 CCID50 per dose, prefilled oral applicator – new listing
- Tuberculin PPD [Mantoux] test (Tubersol) inj 5 TU per 0.1 ml, 1 ml vial – new listing, Xpharm

Possible decisions for future implementation 1 July 2017

- Azithromycin 250 mg and 500 mg tablets (Apo-Azithromycin) and granules for oral liquid 200 mg per 5 ml (40 mg per ml) (Zithromax) – restriction amendment to max 5 days treatment per prescription, can be waived by Special Authority
- Bendamustine inj 25 mg vial and inj 100 mg vial (Ribomustin) and inj 1 mg for ECP (Baxter) – new listing with Special Authority, PCT only - Specialist
- Enoxaparin sodium (Clexane) all subsidised strengths – Special Authority criteria amendment
- Erlotinib (Tarceva) tab 100 mg and 150 mg – Special Authority criteria amendment
- Gefitinib (Iressa) tab 250 mg – Special Authority criteria amendment
- Lamivudine (Zeffix) tab 100 mg and oral liquid 5 mg per ml – Special Authority criteria amendment
- Ledipasvir with sofosbuvir (Harvoni) tab 90 mg with sofosbuvir 400 mg – Special Authority criteria amendment
